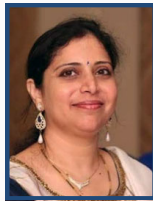

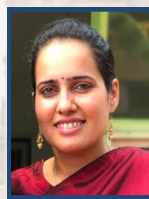

General Guidelines:

- Abstract must be related to bleeding and thrombotic disorder.
- It must be informative with a maximum word limit of 300 words, excluding the title, authors & affiliation, sections heading (background, Aims, Methods, Result, Conclusion)
- Abstract must describe an original work, case report or case series.
- A maximum of one table or image in JPG format is allowed.
- All abstracts will be reviewed by the abstract review committee and the accepted abstracts will be allocated to Oral or poster presentation mode, The same will be notified to the presenting author through email.

Abstract must be submitted in word format with following headings:

- Title:
- Authors Name (Presenting authors name should be first)
- Affiliations
- Introduction
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusion
- Keywords

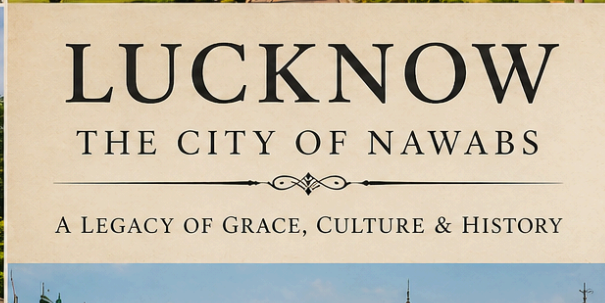
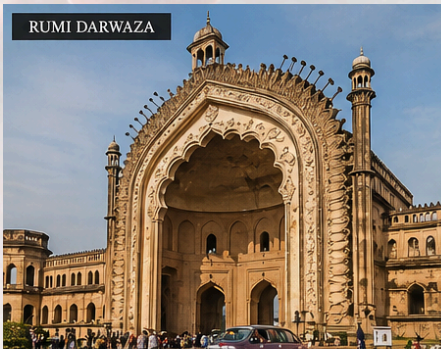
